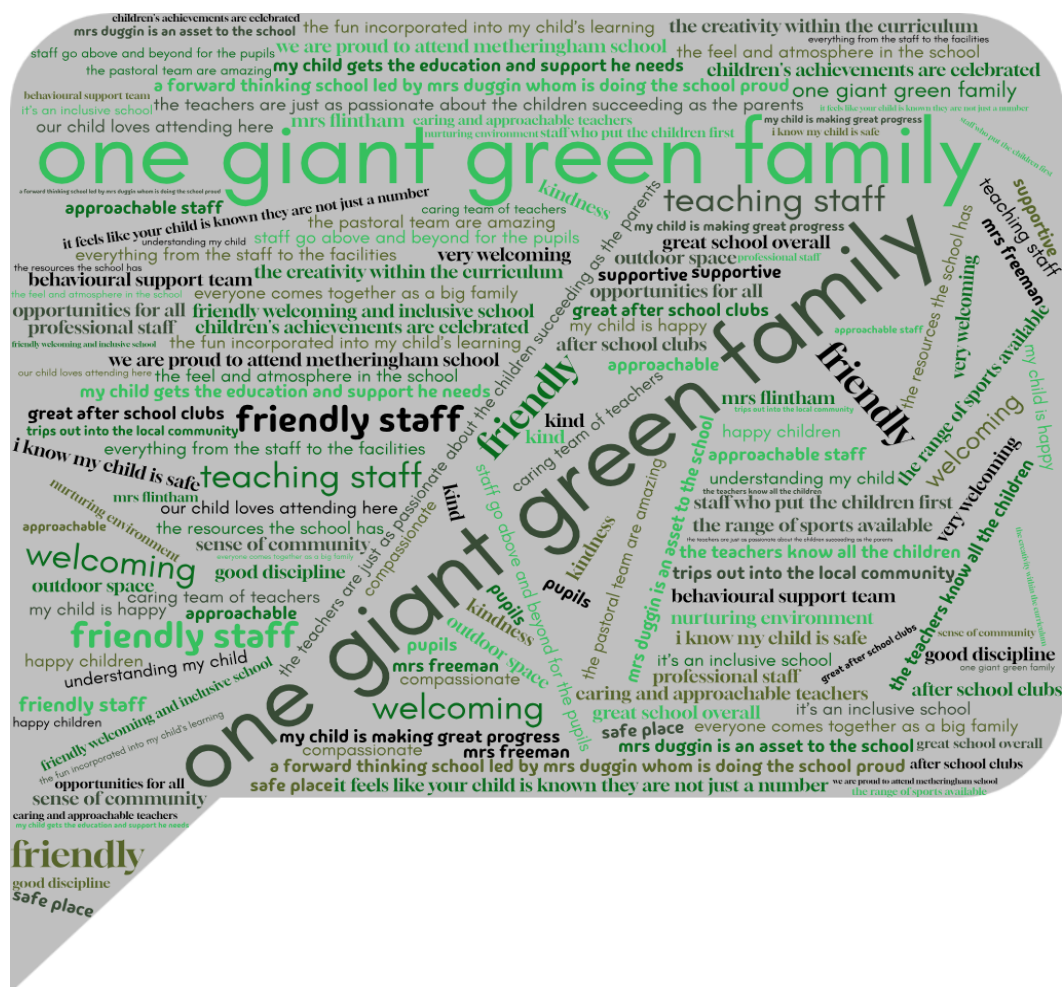

Frequent suggestions from surveys:

1. Before and After School Care

We appreciate that some parents would prefer to have onsite before and after school care but we also acknowledged the incredible provision that is already in the village. We continue to work closely with the village providers to determine if demand is being met by their provision.

2. After School Clubs

Our extra-curricular club offer is extensive and the variety of clubs is an incredible offer. There are options every term for years 1-6. Reception clubs do not start until the spring term to ensure the children have transitioned and adjusted to school life before extending their day in school. We try to ensure a balance of paid and unpaid clubs. Staff volunteer their time after school to make this provision happen. Our Sports Crew and School Council regularly gain pupil voice on the types of clubs that would like to see at Metherringham.

3. Trips and out of school opportunities

We endeavour to put together an overview of our trips and extra-curricular activities to ensure parents and carers know what their child can expect to experience in terms of trips and out of school opportunities in each year group.
