Home Learning

Reading: This term, we will be revisiting all of our graphemes that we have learnt so far. Please read with your child using their Phonics reading book at least four times a week to enable them to build up fluency of reading. Enjoy sharing their 'Love of Reading' book; this can be shared in different ways **eg: you can read it to them, they can spot digraphs in the text, they can use their phonics to sound out words, you can read a page each throughout the book.**

Maths - This term, we will continue to look at groups of amounts that can make different numbers up to 10. Please encourage your child to use objects at home or their fingers to tell you which numbers make the amount. Eg: $4 + 3 = 7$, $6 + 1 = 7$, $5 + 2 = 7$
